New Turkey programme following Tandem Turkey

Tandem Culture Without Borders is a cultural collaboration programme that strengthens civil society in Europe and its neighbouring regions.

The program is implemented together with Anadolu Kültür and European Cultural Foundation and completed its fifth round in July 2019. Since 2011, more than 60 collaborations were supported, bringing together circa 150 participants from cultural organisations and civil society from Turkey, Europe, and the neighboring regions.

The programme provided cultural operators from all over Turkey, working in arts and culture and civil society organizations using art as a medium for social change, the opportunity to form and learn from cross-border tandem partnerships. The programme acted on many different levels, offering professional development to individuals, as well as supporting organisational change processes, creating a space to experiment with innovative ideas for social change and nurturing local cultural change-makers.
